

**BYLAW 14-04
TOWN OF BLACK DIAMOND**

**A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE AMENDMENT OF LAND USE BYLAW 98-14
WITHIN THE TOWN OF BLACK DIAMOND, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA.**

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, Revised Statutes 2000, Council of the Town of Black Diamond in the Province of Alberta (hereinafter called the “Council”) has adopted Land Use Bylaw No. 98-14; and

AND WHEREAS the Town of Black Diamond deems it desirable to amend the said Bylaw; and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Black Diamond, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That the following definitions be added to Part 2 (Definitions)

“Livestock” means:

- i. A horse, mule, ass, swine, emu, ostrich, camel, llama, alpaca, sheep or goat;
- ii. domestically reared or kept deer, reindeer, moose, elk ,or bison;
- iii. farm bred fur bearing animals, including foxes and minks;
- iv. animals of the bovine species;
- iv. animals of the avian species including chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese, pigeons or pheasants; and
- v. all other animals that are kept for agricultural purposes, but does not include dogs, cats or other domesticated household pets.

“Grazing Lease” means land used for the outdoor foraging of livestock on vegetation grown on site, at a density not exceeding 1 animal per 1.6 hectares (4 acres).

2. That the following use be removed from Section 10.2.9.3 (Industrial District List of Discretionary Uses)
 - Small Animal Breeding and/or Boarding Establishments
