



Outdoor Watering Conservation

Commencing June 7, 2010 until the end of August, 2010 (unless otherwise notified), the following outdoor watering conservation measures will be mandatory in the Town of Black Diamond in an effort to ensure an even distribution of water during peak demand.

To determine what days are available to you for outdoor watering, please use the last number of your house address, and determine if your property is considered **ODD** or **EVEN**.

EVEN numbered addresses can water lawns **as needed** on **Wednesdays & Saturdays** between the hours of **5:00am to 9:00 am** and **8:00 pm to midnight**

ODD numbered addresses can water lawns **as needed** on **Thursdays & Sundays** between the hours of **5:00am to 9:00 am** and **8:00 pm to midnight**

Please remember, lawns only require 2.5 cm (1 inch) of water weekly, and watering during these scheduled hours will ensure maximum absorption.

**Exceptions can be made for newly seeded lawns or for new sod.
